- (A) The instant case is an extraordinary writ proceeding.
- (B) The case is confidential pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(8).
- (C) The identity of the parties is not confidential.
- (D) The docket in this case is not confidential.
- (E) All court records in this case are confidential.
- (F) The Petitioner, the Respondent, the attorneys of record in this case or their agents, and necessary court personnel are permitted to view the sealed items.
- (G) The degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(c); and no less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth in rule 2.420(c).


