The Florida Board of Bar Examiners has announced a correction to the results from the February 2019 General Bar Examination. Three of the 599 applicants taking the overall examination for the first time were originally misclassified as having been unsuccessful on the examination. Each of these applicants has been contacted regarding this issue and advised of their success on the examination. The board has also contacted 36 applicants to notify them about a correction to their scores even though their overall passing status did not change.
