The Florida Board of Bar Examiners, through its Chair, the Honorable David C. Reeves of Jacksonville, Florida, has announced that the grades from the February 2020 General Bar Examination have been approved for release by the Supreme Court of Florida.

On February 25-26, 2020, 1,717 applicants took the Bar Examination in Tampa, Florida. The Supreme Court posted the pass/fail results for each applicant on its website and score reports were mailed to each applicant today.

The Court approved 421 candidates for admission to The Florida Bar on April 13, 2020, and Chief Justice Charles T. Canady has announced that they may be sworn in as members of The Florida Bar. Formal induction ceremonies that were scheduled for May 4, 2020 have been canceled due to the Coronavirus pandemic. Applicants may be sworn in by any judge or notary who is authorized to administer an oath.

## FEBRUARY 2020 GENERAL BAR EXAMINATION OVERALL METHOD
