The Florida Board of Bar Examiners, through its Chair, the Honorable Jane A. Rose of Tampa, Florida, has announced that the grades from the February 2021 Bar Examination have been approved for release by the Supreme Court of Florida.

On February 23-24, 2021, 1,854 applicants took the online remote Bar Examination. The Supreme Court posted the pass/fail results for each applicant on its website and score reports were mailed or posted to each applicant's portal today.

The Court approved 502 candidates for admission to The Florida Bar on April 12, 2021, and Chief Justice Charles T. Canady has announced that they may be sworn in as members of The Florida Bar. Remote, formal induction ceremonies hosted by the Florida District Courts of Appeal will be held to swear in the new attorneys on May 3, 2021.
